Pre-Trip Inspection

Picking Up The Load	1

Squares up to the location and stops about 1 foot away	1 2 3 4

Moves forward slowly	1 2 3 4	
If the load is on a pallet, lowers it into position and lowers the forks further	1 2 3 4	
Look over both shoulders before backing out	1 2 3 4	
Backs straight out until the forks have cleared	1 2 3 4	
Lowers the forks to traveling position	1 2 3 4
